

Group Lesson and Orchestra Rules

- I. Each student should wear a name tag placed on the right front near their shoulder and sign the attendance form. Forms and name labels will be at the front of the building and in each room.
- 2. Students should place their cases along the perimeter of the walls of the room.
- 3. Parents and students should help set up and tear down the areas according to the teachers instructions. We must leave the school spotless please help clean the areas that we use.
- 4. Please do not consider the classes to be a drop off activity for your child. Parents/Guardians should stay in the room with the student they are responsible for.
- 5. Lessons are cell free zones. Please refrain from using electronic devices except for note taking as you observe the classes.

- 6. Attending adults should be silent supporters during group lessons Teachers will invite the adults to participate when appropriate.
- 7. No food during lessons, unless the Teachers arrange a celebration/party.
- 8. Siblings are not allowed to roam the building.
- 9. When time for orchestra, students should find their appropriate seat quickly. Please make sure you have a sharpened pencil and your music folder on the stand.
- 10. Parents should continue to observe during orchestra class. Later this year, we may have Parent Education

- II. Please no talking during group classes or orchestra. If you need to have a conversation with another parent please use the music room.
