After getting a Master's degree in Mental Health Counseling in 2005, she started working as a Clinical Counselor, most recently at Cincinnati Children's Hospital in the Therapeutic Preschool and the Healing Center where she specializes in the treatment of psychological trauma. As a teacher her approach is centered on teaching students according to their needs and learning styles, nurturing both the ability and the desire to learn, and having a supportive and collaborative partnership with parents.
